Additional conditions for participation CAI Saumur (2-6 june 2021)

To prevent the impact of COVID-19 and EHV-virus during the event, there are some instructions to follow:

COVID - 19

- 1 All competitors and teams must perform a quick PCR test, less than 72 hours before their arrival. This will be checked by a steward at the entrance. The entire team must arrive at the same time.
- 2 The quick test is for everyone
- 3 Maximum people allowed per team: Single Horse/Pony: 1 driver, 3 people Pair Horse/Pony: 1 driver, 4 people Team Horse/Pony: 1 driver, 5 people Children up to the age of 10 will be accepted
- 4 Arrivals are only possible on Tuesday, June 1
- $H4 P4 \rightarrow 8$ a.m. to 11 a.m.
- $H2 P2 \rightarrow 11$ a.m. to 3 p.m.
- $H2 P1 \rightarrow 3 \text{ p.m. to 5 p.m.}$
- 5 It is not possible to arrive on Wednesday, June 2
- 6 If necessary, leaving the site is allowed
- 7 Authorized people per nation: 1 coach, 1 Chef d'equipe, 1 veterinarian; these people must have done the quick test and present it when arriving on Tuesday
- 8 No one will be accepted on the site if they do not have their test
- 9 Obligation to wear the mask on site.

EHV-virus

As a precaution, the groom or driver will have to take the temperature of their horses/ponies at the entrance of the boxes, with passport checks. If a horse/pony has an abnormal temperature, it will be put under observation.
