INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL COMPETITORS

Please note that this is basic information, please ensure you refer to the schedule

Driving Secretary contact

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Accidents and Incidents	Any accidents or incidents that occur outside of the competition must be reported to the Secretary immediately.
Accreditation and Vehicle Passes	Wristlets will be issued to all competitors and grooms on arrival. Each individual must come to the office to get their wristlet. Additional wristlets can be bought. All horseboxes must carry a fire extinguisher . Space is restricted so please follow the specific instructions given by the stewards.
Arrival and Parking	From 4.00pm Tuesday 9th May. If you wish to park next to a friend please arrive with them there will be no reserving parking spaces. The postcode for the showground is: SL4 1QE . GPS Coordinates 51°29'16.16"N; 0°36'06.09"W. Please follow the event signage. All CAI competitors' lorries will be parked within the showground. You will be checked into the showground using your competitor name . You will be directed to a marked space whilst we will try to fit 1x lorry and trailer and 1x car and caravan in this space if it does not fit the extra will have to go to the area on the other side of Victoria Bridge ('CAI Overflow' on the attached map). No extra vehicles will be allowed in the lorry area. Security is high and we ask for your patience.
Barbecues	No barbecues in the lorry or stable area.
Bicycles	Bicycles will be allowed out to the Dressage Arena and Obstacles, however on Saturday no bicycles will be allowed into the obstacle area for the duration of the marathon. No bicycles will be allowed past Double Cottages until the Marathon on Saturday 13 th May.
Caravans	One caravan space per competitor is allowed, any additional caravans will be charged £150 and may not be near the lorry.
Dogs	No dogs in the stable or lorry parking area.

Electricity	Is available at £65 per connection. Please ensure that you bring the correct leads, we cannot guarantee connection at all times and suggest that you bring a back-up alternative. Any electrical appliances or connections not conforming will be disconnected and if dangerous destroyed. (The connection to our dist boards is a 16AMP 240VOLT 2PIN and EARTH CEE FORM BLUE PLUG).
Entry Fees and EADCMP Charges	All competitors are to have paid their Entry Fees and the EADCMP charge before the start of competition.
Exercise Route & Practise Arena	Competitors may only take the route out into the Park as issued by the Secretary – competitors must stay on the hard roads and tracks at all times failure to do so could result in elimination from the competition. – no lunging, riding or exercising may take place within the stable area. There will be a practise arena made available with times allocated by the FEI Steward.
Lunging	There is an allocated area. There is to be no use of the car/lorry park for lunging.
Ridden Horses	The rider of any ridden horse must wear a hard hat.
Numbers & Paperwork	Horse and carriage numbers are provided by the competitors. Numbers must be worn at all times when horses are out of their stables.
Stables - Access	Wristlets must be worn at all times. Access will only be available to those with wristlets. All horses will be stabled in show temporary stabling. No horses will be allowed to stable with their lorries (this includes all GBR).
Stables and Tack Box	All horses have stables booked in compliance with the Schedule. Lorries will be parked outside the stabling compound. There are no spare tack boxes available.
Stables - Bedding	All stables are provided with 2x bales shavings free. More shavings are available on-site. No straw is available.
Stables - Water	Buckets only – hosepipes are banned from being attached to the standpipes within the stable area.
Stables - Vets/Doctors/Farriers	Vets, doctors and farriers can be contacted through the Stable Managers Office. Any fee incurred will be the responsibility of the competitor.
Drinks Reception	There will be a Drinks Reception on Friday 13 th May at 6.30pm, invitations are for all Drivers plus one Guest and Chefs d'Equipes only. Invitations will be issued on arrival. It is not possible to purchase further invitations to this reception.
Marathon Course	Course Inspection: Mini Motorbikes/Quad Bikes are NOT ALLOWED unless authorised by the OC prior to arrival. (Those who are disabled or unable to ride a bicycle will be allowed their mini motorbikes). All other competitors are to use BICYCLES to get around the show ground. Obstacles can only be inspected on foot. Any failure to adhere to the above will be severely reprimanded by the President of the Jury.
